








4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as ³⁶⁴ responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?






8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social andemotional growth.




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 364 responses








11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.






13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges. 362 responses








15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.






17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities. 364 responses








19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. whileteaching.
